

Delaware Senior Olympics

Qualifying Rules:

1. This event is not contested at the National level of the Senior Games.
2. Competitor must be a member of the Delaware Senior Olympics.
3. The 2019 competition will be held 10 August at 10AM, with check-in commencing at 9AM.
4. Shooters must provide their own firearms, ammunition, eye/ear protection and incidental equipment to complete the contest.

Entry/Competition Information:

1. Competition will be one day and competitors will compete in classes of five year increments (ex. 50-54, 55-59, 60-64 and on). Women will compete against women, men against men.
2. Categories of competition are (1) Rimfire (2) Centerfire (3) Flintlock, Percussion, Muzzleloader . All classes will allow metallic or telescopic optics. Shooter may compete in one category only.
3. Spotting scopes are permitted provided the scope is positioned forward of the shooters lead shoulder.
4. Targets used will consist of NRA Military Type SR-1 for centerfire, NRA smallbore TQ-4T and RB 100-8 for muzzleloaders. All targets are single bullseye and will be changed and scored as required. Target is official scorecard.
5. Competitors will fire 50 rounds to complete the course with target change after each 10 rounds.
6. The shooter has the option of shooting from a bench or from the prone position. However, the position chosen must be used for the entire completion. No support devices other than the ground (prone) or bench will be permitted. Example-no bipods, sandbags or other items that will provide support. Exception to that will be attached slings.
7. Shooters will have one minute per shot. Shots will be scored as X-10, 9-9 etc. Where shot touches line, the higher value will be given. Cross firing on another target is a miss. Winner to be determined by highest point total. Ties will be broken by X count.
8. Malfunctions and defective rounds will be dealt with as they occur with range safety the priority.
9. Any competitor who in the opinion of the Range Officer (RO) or other designated official will be disqualified or expelled from the range if their conduct is considered discreditable or unsafe.
10. The governing rule books for the competition are the NRA Small-bore and NRA Large-bore manuals except where modified for the Senior Olympic competition.
